The parties having appeared before the Court on defendant's request for a continuation of the evidentiary hearing in this matter, and the Court having raised questions about the conditions of defendant's release,

The Court having heard the arguments of counsel, and

The Court being fully advised in the premises,

NOW, THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the evidentiary hearing in this matter set for Friday, August 31, 2001, be and hereby is continued to Monday, October 15, 2001, at 9:00 a.m.;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Government shall provide defendant with a list of those witnesses that it intends to call no later than Friday, September 14, 2001; it may add additional witnesses at a later date for good cause shown;



1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the conditions of defendant's supervised release shall
2 remain in full force and effect, with the following additional conditions:


- 3 1. Defendant is not to liquidate any assets, except for (a) reasonable and necessary
4 living expenses at a monthly rate approved by his Probation Officer, (b) medical
5 expenses, and (c) legal expenses.
- 6 2. Defendant is not to himself contact any witnesses other than Mr. John Lewis and
7 United States Probation Officer Todd Sanders; with respect to John Lewis, the
8 defendant is not to discuss the present revocation proceedings.
- 9 3. Defendant is not to destroy any documents or records of any kind that postdate the
10 date of his original sentence in this Court.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any additional prehearing motions shall be filed no later
12 than September 21, 2001, with the response, if any, due by October 1, 2001.
