- Defendant is not to liquidate any assets, except for (a) reasonable and necessary 1. living expenses at a monthly rate approved by his Probation Officer, (b) medical expenses, and (c) legal expenses.
- Defendant is not to himself contact any witnesses other than Mr. John Lewis and 2. United States Probation Officer Todd Sanders; with respect to John Lewis, the defendant is not to discuss the present revocation proceedings.
- 3. Defendant is not to destroy any documents or records of any kind that postdate the date of his original sentence in this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any additional prehearing motions shall be filed no later than September 21, 2001, with the response, if any, due by October 1, 2001.
